Times & Seasons

The Past – 2009

- **Approx. 39 people made professions of faith in Christ**
 - Hong Kong = 150 professions of faith + over 1,000 email/test responses
- **We baptized 19 people**
- **We had 50 people join as covenant members. Our total adult membership at the end of 2009 was 272**
- **Our AVERAGE attendance last quarter of 2009 was 412**
- **Our biggest service in 2009: Christmas Service with 468**
- **63 new discipling relationships were established. Total number of people involved at year end was 302**
- **We supported 11 full time Missionaries**
- **Our total missions support was \$53,598.17**
