

## CHAPTER TWENTY – JUDGMENT DAY

### JUDGMENT DAY – REVELATION 20:1-15

1. The judgment of \_\_\_\_\_ – verses 1-3, 7-10

- His temporary holding cell – The \_\_\_\_\_ pit...
- His momentary release – A \_\_\_\_\_ season...
- His final imprisonment – The lake of \_\_\_\_\_ and brimstone...

2. The millennial reign and judgment of \_\_\_\_\_ – verses 4-6

- The judges
  - Church age \_\_\_\_\_ – Matthew 19:28; Romans 8:17; 2 Timothy 2:12; Revelation 1:5-6; 5:9-10  
*“And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them”*
  - \_\_\_\_\_ saints – Revelation 20:4  
*“and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus...”*

Note: According to God, both of these are part of the first resurrection – There are \_\_\_\_\_ resurrections and they are 1,000 years apart. We see in this passage that the first resurrection was not completed until the end of the tribulation period. The second resurrection will be at the end of the millennium where those resurrected will give an account of their life – Dan. 12:2; Acts 24:15, Rev. 20:14

- Their role
  - \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_  
*Kings rule nations while priests are set apart for special service unto God and Christ  
The apostles will fill this role as it concerns the nation of \_\_\_\_\_ – Mt. 19:28  
The church and tribulation saints will fulfill this role to the nations – Rev. 1:6; 5:10; 20:6*
- The \_\_\_\_\_ frame
  - A \_\_\_\_\_ years – Revelation 20:2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7
  - Also referred to as the Millennium – from the Latin words Mille (1,000) and Annum (year)

3. The great \_\_\_\_\_ throne judgment – verses 11-15

- The judge – Almighty God...the \_\_\_\_\_ – John 5:19-29
  
- The judged – The \_\_\_\_\_, small and great
  - Small: Farmers, maids, butlers, electricians, bricklayers, clerks, storekeepers, welders, machinists, accountants, attorneys, mailmen, bookkeepers, soldiers, airmen, marines, sailors, seaman, merchants, doctors, salesmen, engineers, truck drivers, deliverymen, mothers, fathers, teachers, foremen, supervisors, sanitation workers, printers, pressmen, nurses, dentists, dental workers, professors, pastors, priests, deacons, sons, daughters, grandmothers, grandfathers, aunts, uncles, singers, policemen, waiters, cashiers, businessmen, etc., etc., etc.
  
  - Great: Pharaohs, kings, presidents, dictators, cabinet members, senators, congressmen, generals, admirals, corporate magnates, industrialists, governors, mayors, government officials, rich men and women, Media moguls, movie stars, professional athletes, etc., etc., etc.
  
- The books and another \_\_\_\_\_ – which is the book of life
  - Some possibilities:
    - 1) Since God is not willing that any should perish (2 Peter 3:9) the book of life contains all the names of everyone ever born. Ultimately, those who \_\_\_\_\_ Christ have their names blotted out of the book...
  
    - 2) A book that contains books could be the \_\_\_\_\_ itself...
  
  - The judgment
    - Every man was judged according to their \_\_\_\_\_
  
    - Whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of \_\_\_\_\_
  
    - Strange and sobering facts about hell:

94% of Americans believe in \_\_\_\_\_; 81% believe in judgment day  
81% of religious believe in life after death; 50% of non-religious believe in life after \_\_\_\_\_  
66% believe in heaven; 46% fully expect to spend eternity in \_\_\_\_\_  
53% believe in hell  
\_\_\_\_\_ expect to spend eternity in hell

33% of born again believers think that hell is a real place and most will go there  
37% of born again believers do not believe it is a real place, but is simply separation from God  
\_\_\_\_\_ of born again believers think that hell is a symbolic term and not a real place at all  
11% of born again believers are undecided about their views on hell
