



Enoch is a very \_\_\_\_\_ character in the Bible—there is no one quite like him. He is first mentioned here in Genesis 5—the great funeral chapter of the Bible. Yet it is \_\_\_\_\_ said of him that, “*he died.*” Furthermore, he is one of only two people that the Bible says “*walked with God.*” As a matter of fact, the Bible records the phrase “*walked with God*” only three times and twice it is in reference to Enoch (*Genesis 5:22, 24; 6:9*). Although the biblical record of Enoch’s life is sparse, the scriptures that do speak of him, speak volumes. A closer study of this old saint’s life will teach us of our “*walk with God*” and how we can draw \_\_\_\_\_ to the Master throughout all the days of our life.

### ENOCH – NO ONE QUITE LIKE HIM (?)

#### 1. Enoch’s ancestry – verses 18-20

*\*The parenthesis beside the year of death indicates the age of the man at his death*

- *Methuselah was born in the year 687; he lived 969 years; therefore, he died in the year \_\_\_\_\_ (687 + 969 = 1656)*

- Noah was born in the year 1056; he was 600 years old when the flood waters came (Genesis 7:6); therefore, the year of the flood was \_\_\_\_\_ (1056 + 600 = 1656)
- Methuselah is the \_\_\_\_\_ man on record – 969 years – Genesis 5:27; 2 Peter 3:9
