 - 1. Moses, man of God, of effectual fervent _____ (Ps. 90; 106:23; Jer. 15:1)
 - 2. Mount of Transfiguration (Mt. 17:3-4)...numerous N.T. quotes...
 - 3. Moses starting point Jesus’ discourse on prophecies re: Him (Lk. 24:27)
 - 4. Moses’ body disputed over by Michael the archangel with _____ (Jude 9)
 - 5. Moses’ _____ sung in heaven (Rev. 15:3) with the Song of the Lamb
- B. The preserved Word of God (Ps. 12:6-7)
 - 1. Cf. 2 Tim. 3:8
 - 2. We ARE in the last minutes of the last _____ of the reprobate church (2 Tim. 3:1)
 - a. Which has failed to preach His Word (2 Tim. 4:2), avoiding sound doctrine
 - b. Lusting after entertaining “ministries” (2 Tim. 4:3)
 - c. Turning away from the _____, and not turning from sin (repentance)(4:4)
- C. Thusly, we need a “fresh exodus” from this Satanic world and the grip of “Pharaoh”
- D. As we follow Moses’ teachings as a _____ of Deliverer – Christ (PTL for our timeless Bible)!!

II. INSTRUCTION- EXODUS CHAPTER ONE...“ISRAEL IN BONDAGE”

- A. God had blessed Israel with the best land (Gen. 47:11-12)
- B. God blessed them with 30 years of grace, pictured in His protective watch-care over Joseph (1:7; Gen. 50:20)
 - 1. Where they multiplied from 70 to 2 million! (Num. 1:46)
 - 2. As God promised (Gen. 35:11-12; Num. 23:19)
- C. Then a new king arose who knew not Joseph (v8), who hated God’s people (Jn. 15:18-19)

- D. Afflictions abounded 430 years, but they multiplied more by His grace (v11-12)...as God had eternal purposes to accomplish in fulfilling His promises to Jacob and Abraham:
1. To prepare Israel for her inheritance of the promised _____ (type of heaven)
 2. To develop spiritual muscle through trials of perseverance (count the cost)
 - a. Cf. 2 Cor. 12:10ff; Job 13:15; 42:5-6; Ps. 119:67
 - b. To later appreciate the land flowing with milk and honey (I Sam. 12:24)
 - c. To _____ God's precious promises, forever settled in heaven (Mt. 24:35)
 3. To develop into a nation of 2 million people so they would have a large enough _____ of soldiers to fight the enemies of Canaan (2 Tim. 2:2ff) in the Promised Land...
 4. To punish Israel's family for their conspiratorial treatment of Joseph, a type of Christ...the sins of the fathers to the next generations (3rd, 4th)
 - a. Just as Joseph was a _____ in Egypt...
 - b. So will be his brethren who betrayed him...(Gal. 6:7)
 - c. Cf. Christ...as Israel betrayed Him into the hands of Gentiles for judgment...God let Rome judge them (70AD)...to this day! ("let His blood be on us and our children!")
 5. To foreshadow that the deliverance supernaturally from Egyptian bondage, parallels the redemption of sinners by Christ from the bondage of this _____ (Heb. 2:14)
- E. Midwives are told to kill the sons (v16)
1. Pharaoh's wisdom (I Cor. 3:19)
 2. God blesses, birth of Moses (Christ), Satan opposes (Herod) – Cf. 1 Cor. 1:19... remember, Satan's _____ always opposes God's Seed (Gen. 3; Rev. 12:4)
- F. BUT...the midwives feared God! (v17)...(Ro. 8:31-32)
1. And did NOT Satan's will...normal Christian _____ (2 Cor. 7:1)
 2. BUT saved the men (17b)...God's _____ (Prov. 21:30)
 - a. For all men to be _____ (I Tim. 2:3-4)
 - b. Cf. 2 Pe. 3:9
 - c. Consequently, God blesses them with houses(v20-21; Ps. 91:1); and multiplies the people...PTL – how He _____ to reverse things (Gen. 50:20)
 - i. Houses = gave them husbands and children...
 - ii. 2 Sam. 7:11-12

- d. The _____ of God always bestows grace to overcome evil (Ps. 111:10; Heb. 12:28-29)
 - e. God always remembers to bless faith that takes _____ (I Sam. 2:30; Heb. 6:10)
3. Midwives knew well that children were a gift from God Himself (Ps. 127:3)
- a. And that nothing could stop God's plan to grow Israel into a powerful nation
 - b. Thusly, the Hebrew women were very healthy and gave birth easily (v19)
- G. SO...Pharaoh charges all HIS people to murder the _____ of Israel (v22; Jn. 8:44)
1. The Dragon moved Herod to attempt to kill Jesus (Rev. 12)
 2. Again, the battle of the seeds (Gen. 3:15)
 3. Satan empowers people who must be punished (Eccles. 8:11) or they go from bad to _____ (2 Tim. 3:13)
 - a. God's grace gives time to repent...
 - b. Cf. Israel's 40 years of _____ after the crucifixion...
 - c. Then He sends in Titus and the Roman army to destroy Jerusalem – 70AD
